

# Statement of Vision and Mission

**Our Vision** is to see restored in the church sound biblical doctrine and faith-practice relative to the Father’s end-purpose for having sent His Son to die on the cross and for now sending His Spirit to reconcile to Himself men and women, that He might receive *worship in Spirit and truth* (John 4:23-24), *a fragrance of Christ to God* (2Cor 2:15), from those whom the apostle named *the called of Jesus Christ* (Rom 1:6) and *children of God* (Rom 8:16-17).

**Our Mission** is to faithfully teach and represent, to all who would have ears to hear, the biblical message about the Father’s two-dimensional plan of salvation; His sovereign near-purpose *through the faith which is from Jesus Christ* (Rom 3:22), aka positional *forensic* justification, and His cooperative end-purpose in the believer’s volitional dying-to-self according to *the obedience from faith* (Rom 1:5, 16:26) into *spiritually-spoken worship* (Rom 12:1), aka functional *sanctifying* justification. Our mission is to support a network of home churches, whereby online viewers might become host to a small fellowship of believers in their homes, allowing Legacy Bible Church to provide biblical teaching, encouragement, and exhortation for local fellowship *in Christ*.
